- 5- Plan for weekly kids event with other leaders (event planning/teamwork)
- 6- Teach weekly kids event (communication)
- 7- Plan Summer Youth and Kids Budget (financial planning)
- 8- Administrative contact with youth for events and care (client service)
- 9- Weekly outreach events for church (client service)

Schedule (35 hours week)

Sunday morning from 8am -12 noon as a dedicated kids worker (4 hours)

Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday 9am to 5pm (7.5 hours a day, but a half an hour lunch break is provided)

Thursday 1:00pm-10pm as leader of youth group (8.5 hours, but half hour off at dinner time)

*Note, this job requires you work on Canada Day at the church booth at the Barrhaven community event, and the day before June 30th in planning and prep.
